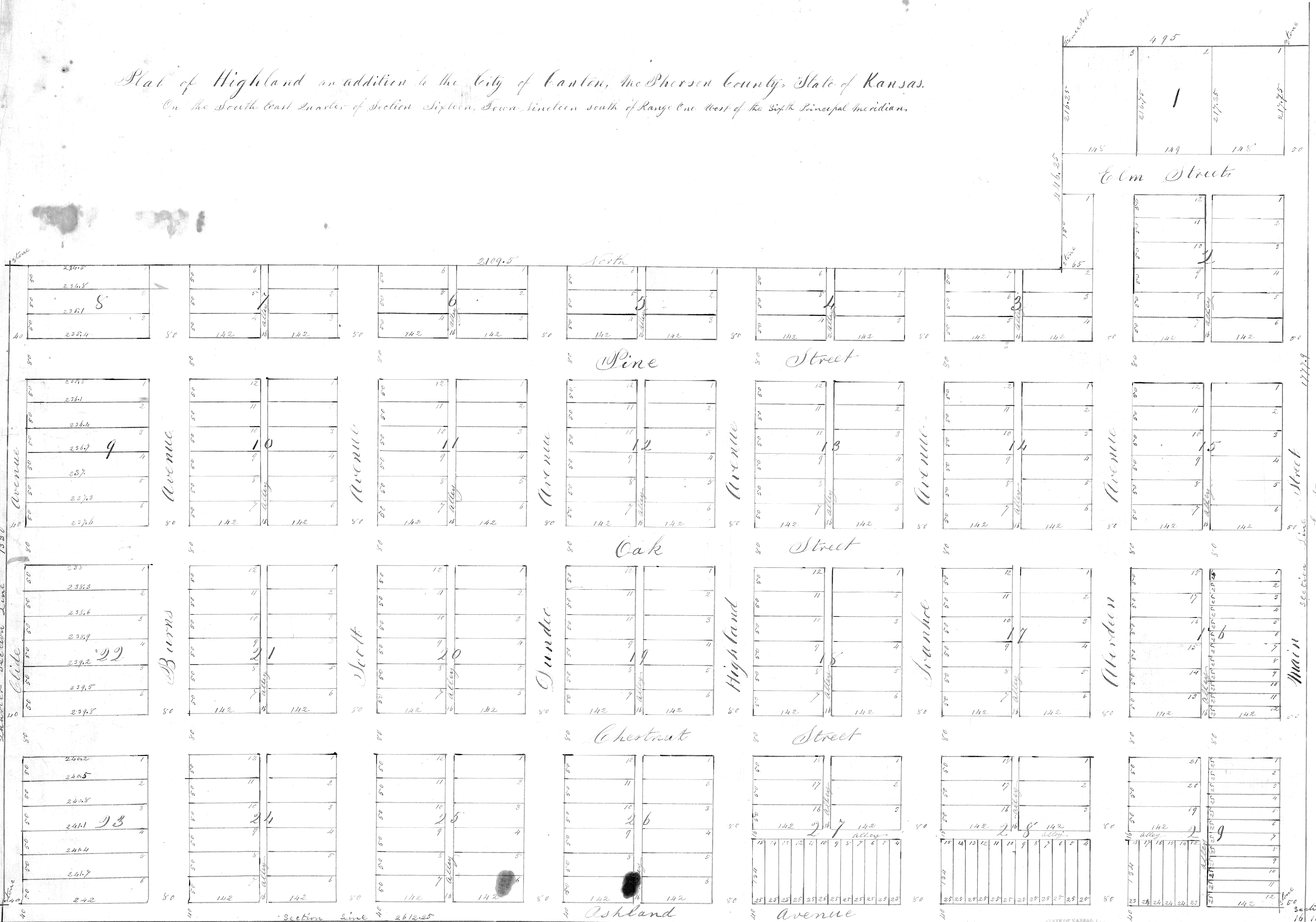


Plat of Highland an addition to the City of Canton, McPherson County, State of Kansas.

On the South East Quarter of Section Sixteen, Town Nineteen south of Range One West of the Sixth Principal Meridian.



Surveyors Description.
The initial point of this survey is the meeting of the boundary lines of sections 15-16-21 and 22 of town nineteen south of Range one west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in the County of McPherson State of Kansas, the same being the South East corner of the aforesaid section sixteen. Thence running on the south line of said section sixteen westerly 2612.25 feet to the Quarter section line of said section sixteen, thence on said Quarter section line northerly 40 feet to the intersection of lines thus cut in a stone set in the ground, thence continuing said northerly line to 1380 feet to the intersection of lines thus cut in a stone set in the ground, thence easterly on a line parallel with the south line of said section sixteen 2109.5 feet to the intersection of lines thus cut in a stone set in the ground. Thence northerly on a line parallel with the east line of said section sixteen 446.25 feet to a fence post being the South West corner of land now used for a cemetery. Thence easterly on south line of said cemetery 445 feet to the intersection of lines thus cut in a stone set in the ground thence continuing said easterly line to 495 feet to the East line of said section sixteen, thence southerly on said East line 1777.9 feet to the initial point.

All numerals for measurement express the number of feet. All fractions are expressed in Decimals.

The Land enclosed by the aforementioned lines is divided by Avenues and Streets (of width expressed by the numerals in them on the plat) into Blocks and numbered from 1 to 29 both inclusive by numerals in and near the center of each block. The South East corner of Block 29 is at the intersection of lines thus cut in a stone set in the ground 45 feet northerly and 50 feet westerly of initial point.

All blocks except 1-5-9-22 and 23 are divided by alleys 16 feet in width as expressed on the plat.

All blocks are subdivided into lots and by the numeral in and near the North East corner of each lot numbered.

The extent of each lot is expressed in feet by the numerals in and near the South and West lines of the Block or lot.
